

Grant Title: AMERICAN LEGION CHILD WELFARE FOUNDATION GRANT

Area of Research: Grants that have the potential of helping American children in a large geographic area (more than one state).

Application Deadline: Completed Applications July 15 (annually). Applications are mailed to requesting organizations upon request: April 1 through July 1 (annually). Requests received after July 1 will be held for the next grant award year.

Amount: Amount not stated. Average amount awarded to 16 non-profit organizations in 2007 was approximately \$25,500.

Length of Support: One year. All grants must be completed between the period of January 1 - December 31 of the award year.

Eligible Applicants: Nonprofit organizations

Agency/Department: American Legion Child Welfare Foundation

Summary: Proposals are accepted from nonprofit organizations for projects which meet one of the Foundation's two basic purposes: To contribute to the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual welfare of children through the dissemination of knowledge (1) about new and innovative organizations and/or their programs designed to benefit youth; and (2) already possessed by well-established organizations, to the end that such information can be more adequately used by society.
