Grant Number: PAR-06-448

Area of Research: Health services research projects.

Release and Expiration: June 7, 2006 release; November 17, 2008 expiration.

Application Deadline: *R03-New:* February 16, June 16, October 16 annually; *Resubmissions:* March 16, July 16, November 16 annually.

Amount: *R03:* Up to 100,000 per award.

Length of Support: Up to 2 years.

Eligible Applicants: Non-profit organizations; public or private institutions, such as universities, colleges; units of local or State government; eligible agencies of the Federal government; faith-based or community-based organizations; and Tribal governments and organizations.

Agency/ Department: DHHS; AHRQ

Summary: This program supports different types of health services research projects including pilot and feasibility studies; secondary analysis of existing data; small, self-contained research projects; development of research methodology; and, development of new research technology. The current priority areas of AHRQ include: translating research into practice and policy; patient safety and quality; patient-centered care; and payment and organization.
