

Grant Title: ALCOHOL USE DISORDERS: TREATMENT, SERVICES RESEARCH, AND RECOVERY (R01)

Funding Opportunity Number: PA-07-066

Area of Research: Support research on behavioral and pharmacological treatment for alcohol use disorders.

Release & Expiration Dates: November 20, 2006 release; July 6, 2009 expiration.

Application Deadline: *New:* February 5, June 5, October 5, annually; *Resubmissions:* March 5, July 5, November 5 annually; *AIDS-Related:* May 1, September 1, January 2 annually.

Amount: *R01:* Typically under \$500,000 per year in direct costs.

Length of Support: *R01:* Up to 5 years.

Eligible applicants: For-profit or non-profit institution; public or private institutions, such as universities; eligible agencies of the federal and state government; small business; non-domestic or foreign institutions/ organizations faith-based or community-based organizations; Tribal governments and organizations; Historically Black Colleges & Universities; Hispanic-serving institutions; Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian-serving institutions; regional organizations.

Agency/ Department: NIH; NIAAA

Summary: The purpose of this funding opportunity is to support research on behavioral and pharmacological treatment for alcohol use disorders; organizational, financial, and management factors that facilitate or inhibit the delivery of services for alcohol use disorders; and phenomenon of recovery from alcohol use disorders. Research objectives include, but are not limited to: (1) research on medications for the treatment of alcohol use disorders; (2) research on behavioral interventions for alcohol use disorders; (3) health services research on organization and management of alcohol services; and (4) research on recovery. This funding opportunity seeks applications that address the aforementioned objectives for the population as a whole and in specific subpopulations. In addition, elucidating disparities among racial/ethnic groups with respect to alcohol treatment, service delivery, and recovery is encouraged.
