

Grant Title: AIDS-SCIENCE TRACK AWARD FOR RESEARCH TRANSITION (R03)

Grant Number: PA-07-349

Area of Research: Research in the area of drug abuse research on HIV/AIDS for newly independent and early career investigators.

Release and Expiration: April 3, 2007 release; September 8, 2009 expiration.

Application Deadline: September 7, 2007; September 7, 2008; and September 7, 2009.

Amount: Up to \$100,000 per year in direct costs.

Length of Support: Up to 2 years.

Eligible Applicants: Public, state, and private institutions of higher education; For-profit and nonprofit organizations; small business; State Government; Tribal governments, organizations, and colleges/universities; Hispanic-serving Institution; Historically Black Colleges and Universities; Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian Serving Institutions; or Regional Organizations.

Agency/ Department: NIH; NIDA

Summary: The funding opportunity seeks to facilitate the entry of investigators to the area of drug abuse research on HIV/AIDS, including both newly independent investigators (independent of a mentor but without R01 funding) and early career investigators who seek to add research on the intersection of drug abuse and HIV/AIDS to their research programs. To promote the entry of new investigators into research on the natural history, epidemiology, etiology and pathogenesis, prevention, and treatment of HIV/AIDS in drug abusers, this opportunity will support: pilot or feasibility studies; secondary analysis of existing data; small, self-contained research projects; development of research methodology; and/or development of new research technology. Research objectives include: drug abuse and HIV prevention and/or treatment; epidemiology and natural history of HIV/AIDS among drug using populations; and/or drug abuse related HIV/AIDS and its consequences.
