

**Grant Title:** COLLABORATIVE CLINICAL TRIALS IN DRUG ABUSE

**Grant Number:** PAR-07-232

**Area of Research:** Research regarding the treatment of substance-related disorders.

**Release and Expiration:** February 23, 2007 release; January 3, 2010 expiration.

**Amount:** Typically under \$500,000 per year in direct costs; if request equals or exceeds \$500,000, prior approval is required.

**Length of Support:** Up to 5 years.

**Eligible Applicants:** For profit organizations; Non-profit organizations; Public or private institutions, such as universities, colleges, hospitals and laboratories; small businesses; Units of State and local governments; Units of State and local Tribal government; Hispanic-serving Institution; Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs); Tribally Controlled Colleges and Universities (TCCUs); Alaska Native and Native Hawaiian Serving Institutions; Regional Organization; and Eligible agencies of the Federal government.

**Agency/ Department:** NIH; NIDA

**Summary:** The funding opportunity seeks to increase the collaboration of investigators at different sites in order to address critical issues in the treatment of substance-related disorders that require sample sizes greater than a single site can reasonably attain. The expectation for the collaborative effort is that there will be implementation of common clinical trials across different sites in order to study patient outcomes, patient factors, provider factors, setting characteristics, interactions of these, or other effects where pooled samples are appropriate and necessary for the hypotheses under consideration.
