Amount: Average grant size is \$42,464. 424 grants were awarded in 2003.

Length of Support: Most grants cover a period of one year, however the Foundation accepts requests for funding renewals and also makes multi-year grants.

Eligible applicants: The Public Welfare Foundation does not accept requests to fund scholarships, graduate work, individuals, government projects, academic research of foreign study. They also do not award grants to individuals, and generally do not fund government agencies.

Summary: The Public Welfare Foundation supports organizations that address human needs in disadvantaged communities, with strong emphasis on organizations that include service, advocacy and empowerment in their approach: service that remedies specific problems; advocacy that addresses those problems in a systemic way through changes in public policy; and strategies to empower people in need to play leading roles in achieving those policy changes and in remedying specific problems. The Foundation also likes to fund organizations that link their community and local work to other efforts to effect broader public policy change.
